Notice on Recognition of Loss on Sales of Stocks of Subsidiaries and Affiliates (Consolidated)

As announced in the Notice of Change in a Consolidated Subsidiary (Share Transfer) dated March 31, 2025, Teijin Limited (hereinafter, the "Company") has completed the procedure to transfer all of its shares in Teijin Automotive Technologies NA Holdings Corporation (hereinafter, "TAT"), a wholly owned consolidated subsidiary, to Stork BidCo Inc., a special purpose company of AURELIUS Private Equity Mid-Market Buyout.

As a result, the Company hereby announces that a loss on sales of stocks of subsidiaries and affiliates will be recognized in the consolidated financial statements for the second quarter (July 1 to September 30, 2025) of the fiscal year ending March 2026.

1. Recognition of loss on sales of stocks of subsidiaries and affiliates (consolidated)

Due to the above transfer of shares, the Company's ownership interest in TAT has become zero, resulting in a loss of control over TAT. As a result, the Company will recognize a loss of approximately 11 billion yen on the sales of stocks of subsidiaries and affiliates in the consolidated financial statements for the second quarter of the fiscal year ending March 2026.

2. Outlook

As a result of the above transfer of shares, TAT will be excluded from the Company's consolidated subsidiaries from the second quarter of the consolidated fiscal year ending March 2026. The impact of the transfer of shares on the Company's consolidated financial results has been factored into the outlook for the consolidated financial results for the full fiscal year ending March 2026, which was announced on May 12, 2025. Therefore, no changes have been made to the full fiscal year outlook.
