The ABB FIA Formula E World Championship attracts approximately 500 million viewers globally. Interest is rapidly growing in Japan, where races began in 2024 on a track circling Tokyo Big Sight. The sport is gaining strong support from fans passionate about sustainability and advanced technologies.

Envision Racing is the first team to receive carbon-neutral certification. It actively promotes the adoption of EVs and renewable energy. The team's racing suits feature Teijin's Teijinconex[®] neo meta-aramid, known for its outstanding flame resistance and heat protection. Additionally, the body of the world's first two-seater, all-electric racing car, unveiled by Envision Racing at COP26, incorporates Teijin's TENAX™ carbon fiber, which contributes to weight reduction and enhanced energy efficiency.

Looking ahead, the Teijin Group will co-host climate awareness initiatives as part of the team's Race Against Climate Change™" programme, aiming to address global climate challenges. Through these efforts, Teijin strengthens its purpose, "Pioneering solutions together for a healthy planet," and continues to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society.
