Notice Regarding Fire Incident at Teijin Aramid B.V's Delfzijl Plant in the Netherlands (Second Report)

We hereby announce that a fire incident occurred at the Delfzijl plant of Teijin Aramid B.V (Head Office: Arnhem, the Netherlands; President: Taiichi Machida), a consolidated subsidiary of Teijin Limited, as outlined below. (Updated information is underlined.)

1. Date and Time of Occurrence

August 6, 2025 (Wednesday), around 2:00 PM local time – Fire outbreak August 6, 2025 (Wednesday), around 4:00 PM local time – Fire extinguished

2. Location

Teijin Aramid B.V Delfzijl Plant (Oosterhorn 6, 9936 HD Farmsum, the Netherlands)

3. Cause of Fire

The investigation found that the cause of the fire was a problem with the drying equipment during the manufacturing process of the raw material.

4. Damage Status

No human injuries or environmental impact have been reported.

5. Recovery Status

The plant has mostly been back in operation since August 20, with its operation running safely.

6. Future Measures

We will ensure that recurrence prevention measures will be implemented and make every possible effort to prevent similar fire incidents.

7. Impact on Financial Outlook

A production system that can cope with the predicted upcoming sales demand has been established, and the impact of this incident on the consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ending March 2026 is projected to be minor.
